Shokokuji Temple

Shokoku-ji, officially Mannenzan Shokoku Joten Zenji, is the second of the five leading Rinzai Zen temples in Kyoto during the medieval period. It was built under the auspices of Shogun Ashikaga Yoshimitsu with the Buddha Hall completed in 1394, however, the complex was ravaged by fire and rebuilt numerous times. The characters for "shokoku" mean "a person who helps the country", deriving from a Chinese word meaning "prime minister", while "ji" means "temple".

Enjoy a catered lunch prepared by a Kyoto ryotei at Zonkorou, a large drawing room that is not usually open to the public.

Ikka-in Tofuku-ji Temple & Japanese candle "wa-rousoku" painting



This temple is the head temple of the Rinzai sect of Zen Buddhism, and was founded in 1382 by Zen Master Tozan.

Visitors can learn from craftspeople involved in traditional industries and create their own original traditional crafts. On this day, you can experience "Japanese candle painting."
